Floppy Friends Push Base Horse recalled by
Toy Investments, Inc., due to Violation of
Lead Paint Standard.

Name of Product:

Horris Horse - Model 6471

Units: 300 pieces.

Importer: Toy Investments, Inc.
d/b/a Toysmith, Auburn, WA

Hazard: Surface paint on the orange and dark blue
portions of the flower painted on the base of the toy
contains excessive levels of lead, violating the federal
paint standard.

Incidents/Injuries: None reported.

Description: The recall involves a horse with a push up
base. The horse measures 4 ½" high x 1 ¾" in diameter.

Sold At: Distributed to retail stores between
February 25th and March 11th, 2008.

Manufactured In: China.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately take the toy
away from children and return it to the store where
purchased for a full refund.
